This run also resulted in the first $\$ 1$ million prize won in Nebraska, which continue to educate players about the new features of Powerball in the coming months.

Oular. One $\$ 15,000$ top prize remains in the game, and with The Three Stooges popuar. Ofilm in theaters starting on April 13, we anticipate that the game will be completed soon. Our next $\$ 2$ Scratch game will be the perennial favorite Truck \$ \& Buck\$, which will launch statewide on April 16. Also scheduled to launch this spring is the $\$ 1$ Sodbusting game. This special game celebrates the 150th Anniversary of the Homestead Act, which transformed Nebraska and much of our country.

## \$1 Million

Split By 16 Co-workers.


A group of 16 players from the Omaha area will share a $\$ 1,000,000$ Nebraska Powerball prize.

Each week for almost a decade, Christopher Braun of Omaha and his 15 co-workers at the City of Omaha Roads Department have pooled their money
together to purchase Powerball tickets. the group purchased 16 quick pick tickets at Kwik Shop, 7525 Cass Street in Omaha. One of these tickets contained all five of the winning white ball numbers $(17,28,38,39,51)$ for a corresponding prize of $\$ 1,000,000$.

This is the first automatic million dollar winning ticket in Nebraska since Powerball was upgraded on January 15, 2012. Previously, the amount won for Braun and the members of the group arrived at ters the morning of February 14 to claim the prize. Each person will receive a $\$ 62,500$ share of the prize. The group members had no definite plans for their winnings, but some stated they might use their share to travel, pay bills, or buy a new vehicle.
