We are looking forward to the addition of a new lotto game, Lucky for Life. The game's popularity has grown rapidly, expanding from a handful of New England-area lotteries in 2015 to 23 lotteries currently. Players love the opportunity to win the lottery "for life," with the top prize of \$1,000 a day for life. The game's second prize is \$25,000 a year for life. Further details can be found in this issue of Ticket Talk, and will be rolled out by the Lottery as we approach our late summer launch date.

This year's \$2 Truck\$ & Buck\$ Scratch game features five trucks to be won in the game, rather than three in the game plus one second-chance giveaway. Player response was overwhelmingly popular, prompting the Lottery to add two more trucks to the game, bringing the total number of truck prizes to seven.

All of these efforts will make it easier to have the newest, most-soughtafter Scratch games in your store for players to purchase.

Terminal Tips & Tricks

The Altura lottery terminal is a complex machine, but it's not hard to master. Here are some valuable tips for operating your terminal:

- Even if the barcode on a Scratch or Lotto ticket is damaged, you can still manually validate it in a few simple steps. Tickets can be validated manually by touching Manual Validations, then touching Scratch Validation or Lotto Validation. For Scratch tickets, enter the 14-digit game, pack, and ticket number from the back of the ticket AND the 14digit VIRN number under the latex on the front of the ticket. For a Lotto ticket, enter the 19-digit ticket number. Always activate Scratch ticket packs before selling any tickets to customers. If you do not activate a pack, players will be unable to redeem prizes from that pack until it is activated. To activate packs, touch Scratch Functions, then touch Activate Pack. Scan the barcode from a ticket or enter the game and pack number manually. Enter up to five packs, then touch Send to activate.
- The built-in tools of the Altura can be helpful if you need to look up a previous transaction.

Touch Last Transaction, then touch Last 50 Transactions to display the 50 most recent transactions of any type processed by the terminal. The other options in the Last Transaction section can be used to print receipts for customers if requested.

- You can use your terminal to verify a customer's age by scanning their driver's license. Touch **Age Check**, then scan the barcode on the back of the license.
- If you want to practice using the features of the Altura, you can put the terminal in Training Mode. The terminal must be signed off to enter Training Mode. After signing off, touch **Special Functions** and select **Training On/Off**. When in Training Mode, a yellow background will appear on all screens and any tickets printed will be marked as not for sale. Make sure to sign out of Training Mode before selling tickets to customers by repeating the steps above.
