Holiday Happenings by Brian Rockey, Lottery Director

The holidays have arrived again and, like many years before, it seems that this year has moved by quickly. This year we have accomplished a lot through our products and plan to continue keep that success going well into 2019.

One of the biggest talking points of the last few months was the record-setting jackpot run of Mega Millions. The jackpot reached over \$1 billion, which is a number that proved to be too high for our jackpot signs to handle.

At the time of this publication, the 12 Draws of Christmas promotion is winding down. Players were given the chance to win \$1,000 in drawings that have been held weekly, beginning October 2. The final drawing will be held January 23, 2019 for the grand prize of \$12,000.

Truck\$ & Buck\$ will launch in January. Once again, we will be giving away seven Ford F-150 XLT SuperCrew Flex Fuel trucks and hope that our players will enjoy this iteration of the game as much as the previous Truck\$ & Buck\$ games.

With a new year comes new challenges and opportunities. Everything we anticipate to encounter at the beginning of the new year will be highlighted in this edition of Ticket Talk. Happy Holidays and Happy New Year from all of us at the Nebraska Lottery!

New Year, New Truck\$ & Buck\$

We're ringing in 2019 with the return of the \$2 Truck\$ & Buck\$ Scratch game. The 24th edition of Truck\$ & Buck\$ features the 2019 Ford F-150 XLT 4x4 SuperCrew Flex Fuel truck as the top prize. There are seven trucks to win instantly in the game in addition to over \$2 million in cash and ethanol-enriched fuel

prizes. Look for Truck\$ & Buck\$ to arrive at your store the beginning of January.

BILLBOARDS

Back in October, the Powerball and Mega Millions jackpots were big. Huge. Record-setting.

The \$678.8 million Powerball jackpot won by two people in Iowa and New York on October 27 was massive, but the Mega Millions jackpot from October 23 was even bigger. In fact, the \$1.537 billion jackpot was so big it broke our signs.

The Nebraska Lottery electronic signs are set to go up to \$999 million and after that, things get a little hairy.

Our big billboards just showed "\$999" on the display because that's only how high it was designed to go. When it was designed, \$1 billion or more just wasn't in the cards. To be fair to us, though it's called "Mega Millions" not "Mega Billions".

We had the same problem in January of 2016 when the Powerball jackpot got up to \$1.58 billion, setting a new record for the highest jackpot of any lottery game.

"Surely," we thought, "It could never grow to such heights again."

It did, and, again, our signs stopped working.

Even our in-store displays didn't display anything at all for the \$1.537 billion Mega Millions jackpot.

With the huge dual jackpot run over, the signs returned to working order and will continue to work until the next time the jackpot grows over \$1 billion.







During the holiday season, and throughout the year, the Nebraska Lottery suggests tickets as a gift option for those hard-to-buy-for individuals on your list. However, those individuals should be at least 19 years of age.


By law, Nebraska Lottery tickets may only be purchased and redeemed by persons who are 19 years or older. Every ticket, whether Scratch or Lotto, carries the minimum age (19) reminder, and the same message appears on all in-store signage as well as in broadcast and print advertising.

Lottery tickets aren't child's play. We appreciate your assistance to make sure our products stay out of children's hands.

Nebraska Lottery Events

One of the perks of being an MVP Club member at nelottery.com is receiving valuable eCoupons for Lottery products. At the beginning of November, a Scratch eCoupon was sent to all MVP Club members. This eCoupon offers \$3 worth of Scratch tickets free with the purchase of \$5 in Scratch.

To redeem this eCoupon, have the player make the required purchase then scan the coupon to receive credit. eCoupons can only be redeemed once.





Mistake Tickets

No one likes to make a mistake, especially when purchasing a Lotto ticket. Mistake tickets can cause you wasted time and unnecessary effort, so here's a tip from Lottery Accounting to avoid a common issue.

We always encourage players to use a play slip to choose their numbers. Even if a player fills out a play slip, it's still a good idea to confirm the ticket details and price with them before the ticket is generated. The Altura terminal requires confirmation for any purchase of \$10 more, so a quick double-check will prevent you from producing a ticket a player refuses to buy.

If you do end up with a mistake ticket, try to sell it to another player before draw break. You might be surprised how easy it is to sell a "Lucky Mistake" ticket if you mention it to your customers. Sometimes these tickets really can be lucky. Recently a mistake Nebraska Pick 5 ticket was purchased by Margaret Frerichs of Ogallala along with her correct ticket, and she ended up with two winning tickets for a \$126,000 jackpot.



Toni's Corner

Just northwest of Lincoln on Highway 79 sits Toni's Corner. From the outside it looks like a gas station and convenience store, but step inside and there's a good chance you'll see an international champion dog.

Debbie Martin and her husband Scott Kieffe have run Toni's Corner since 2012, but for a lot of people, it's Diva they come there to see. Diva's a saluki, a breed that looks sort of like a fancy greyhound. She's got long, powerful back legs, a long, pointy snout and black and brown fur.

"She attracts a lot of attention," Martin said. "Everybody goes right to Diva."

Not that Diva doesn't have competition. Martin also has two other salukis, Girlfriend and Shiner, but Diva's the one that takes home the rosettes from competitions.

Back in October, Diva won the American Sighthound Field Association International Invitational competition in Colorado. Chasing a lure through a field, Diva can hit a top speed of about 44 miles per hour.

The pet supply website that Diva's food comes from caught wind of her win and sent her a congratulatory box of toys. A few weeks later another package arrived filled with three oil paintings the website had commissioned featuring Diva, Girlfriend and Shiner.

The paintings hang on the walls of Toni's Corner alongside the watercolors Martin has painted. Toni's Corner is something of an art gallery, featuring Martin's original work that customers can purchase. She's a member of the Lincoln Artists' Guild and has some of her work on display in galleries in Lincoln.

Martin paints birds, muscle cars, landscapes, butterflies. Anything and everything that strikes her fancy. It's her dog paintings that tend to get the most attention at the dog shows and events she takes her pups to that attract the most attention.

Hand-painted canvases and handbags featuring Bernese mountain dogs, poodles and of course salukis are big sellers, but Martin also has a line of decals featuring the outline of Diva at full-sprint that people have started buying.

"There's someone who bought these to put on both sides of their new van," she said.

When they're not at dog shows or art shows or at Kieffe's drag races, they're back in Raymond at Toni's Corner where Nebraska Lottery tickets became a hot item after they sold a \$2 million winning Powerball ticket back in 2015.

"Everyone came in from all over southeast Nebraska after that," Kieffe said. "They didn't buy soda pop, they wanted lottery tickets. We were the lucky store for a while."

Now that winter is here, there aren't a whole lot of dog shows or competitions to attend until spring, Martin said. That'll give her time to paint and sell her art.

"It'll only be worth a lot of money after I die," Martin joked. "You can call me Picasso."
