

Is it really already December? According to my calendar, that is indeed the case and we are gearing up for what we hope is an exciting 2020 and build on the successes of 2019.

One of the highlights of our 2019 was Nebraska Lottery's first Lucky for Life winner of \$25,000 a year for life. Troy Kleffner of Spalding purchased a ticket that matched five of the five winning white ball numbers in the March 25, 2019, drawing.

We ran two successful promotions in fiscal year 2019 that created buzz among our players and led to the highest number of MVP Club activations in one week with 2,455 new accounts. Those were the Lucky Layup Promotion and Big Red Blitz. With the landscape of retail shifting to a more digital landscape, having engagements like this is promising going into the future.

The inception of the Nebraska Lottery in 1993 was aimed to generate revenue for the state, specifically our beneficiaries. Since that time, we have produced funds of more than \$750 million. I'm proud to say that we were able to generate \$46.5 million for our beneficiaries in fiscal year 2019.

Truck\$ & Buck\$ will launch in January and the new iteration of the game will mark its 25th anniversary in Nebraska. We have a number of exciting plans to commemorate this milestone, but perhaps the most visible change is that the trucks will be silver to mark the game's silver anniversary.

We look forward to everything coming in 2020. Happy New Year!

LOTTERY TICKETS AREN'T CHILD'S PLAY.

During the holiday season, the Nebraska Lottery suggests tickets as a gift option for those hard-to-buy-for individuals on your list. However, lottery tickets should only be given to recipients who are at least 19 years of age.

The Nebraska Lottery is participating in the 2019 Holiday Lottery Responsible Gambling Campaign coordinated by National Council on Problem Gambling and the International Centre for Youth Gambling Problems and High-Risk Behaviors at McGill University. Participants agree to help raise awareness about the risks of underage lottery play during the holiday season. We will distribute responsible giving information via a press release and posts on social media.

Retailers can help us raise awareness by reminding players to gift responsibly. No matter how clever or attractive a game may be, it should always be played in moderation and only be given to individuals who are of legal age to play.

#### **Top Prize Odds on Lottery** Advertisements

You might have noticed some additional information on the lottery materials at your store. A new law requires that lottery advertisements include the odds of winning the top prize on the game being advertised in a clear and conspicuous manner. This does not apply to items produced before the law went into effect at the beginning of September.



The recent Black Friday Weekend Special was very popular with players. The \$2 bundle of Nebraska Pick 5. Nebraska Pick 3. and MvDaY tickets was purchased 4.747 times at 644 retailers over the Thanksgiving weekend. Additional terminal bundles will be offered in the future, so look for the temporary "Special" button on your Altura terminal to produce the promotional tickets.





For many of us growing up, watching Dick Clark's Rockin' New Year's Eve was the only way to ring in the New Year. There you were, stuck at home while your older siblings were at parties that you could only imagine were half as exciting as what you were seeing on TV. The spectacle of seeing thousands of people crowded around Times Square, eagerly awaiting the promise of next year was magical. "Would I ever be able to join the party?" you wondered. For three lucky Nebraska Lottery players, the answer is yes.

From July 15 thru September 30, players who purchased a \$3 Powerball with Power Play ticket received an entry voucher for the 2019 First Powerball Millionaire of the Year New Year's Rockin' Eve Promotion. Three winners were selected for VIP trip experience packages to New York City to ring in the new year, but that's not all. Those three winners are also eligible to be selected to win \$1 million live on Dick Clark's New Year's Rockin' Eve.

Winners of the promotion were selected in three drawings that were held August 12, September 9 and October 1. Those winners were Devron Adams of Broken Bow; Kimberly Treague Zerr of Eagan, MN; and Janelle Bowen of Omaha.

The VIP Experience includes roundtrip airfare for two to New York City; a three-night hotel stay at the Crowne Plaza Times Square Manhattan Hotel, two tickets to an iconic theater performance, two tickets for a holiday dinner cruise on the Hudson River, two tickets for an exclusive New Year's Eve dinner and party, two gifts bags both valued at \$100, all meals while in NYC, \$250 spending money and ground transportation to and from airports, hotel and activities while in NYC.

### **Expired prizes: where does** the money go?

Handing out millions of dollars to players each year is a big part of our business. But sometimes a ticket gets misplaced and never gets turned in. So where does that prize money go?

Unclaimed prizes can be used in various ways, but typically cash prizes are used to fund future games. We can also give away an unclaimed prize via a promotion. For example, in 2010 one of the Ford F-150 trucks from the Truck\$ & Buck<sup>\$</sup> Scratch game was never claimed. After selling out all the ticket inventory and closing the game, the truck was given away in the Pick 5 and Drive Ford F-150 Giveaway the following year.

It's rare to have a high-tier Lotto prize expire, but if we know of one that's nearing the expiration date we'll hang posters at the store to remind customers to check their tickets. We'll also post this information on our social media channels and send a release to the media so they can spread the word. This combination is usually enough to get a ticket claimed. Robert Abraham of Omaha claimed a \$1 million Powerball prize shortly before it expired in October 2018. The winning ticket had been sitting on his dining room table for months, and he decided to check it after seeing a news report about the expiring prize.

### **Holiday Ticket Deliveries**

Please be aware that Scratch ticket orders will be affected by the Christmas and New Year's holidays. UPS will not be making deliveries on these holidays, so you may receive more tickets than normal before each one. If you are ordering tickets, please take the holidays into account and order accordingly.

It's been 25 years since the Nebraska Lottery gave away its first truck back in 1996.

In that time, we've given away 108 trucks to Truck\$ & Buck\$ players all across Nebraska, from the top of the panhandle to the southeastern corner of the state.

This year we're trying something new. To celebrate the silver anniversary, we're switching from red trucks to silver ones. Our ticket play style is also changing, and the tickets themselves are embossed with a diamond-plate pattern.

We'll be giving out seven silver 2020 Ford F-150 XLTs, as well as seven \$500 ethanol fuel cards.

Be on the lookout for new 25th anniversary Truck\$ and Buck\$ coming in January.



# **RETAILER SPOTLIGHT**

## Northside Inc.

It was still a few days before Halloween and David City was already getting ready for Christmas.

With jack-o-lanterns still populating porches and bats and cobwebs still stuck to windows, the Hallmark Movie Channel was decorating downtown David City with red, green and white holiday finery. A few Nebraska Lottery retailers got in on the action to help set up the live-TV celebration.

Hallmark Cards founder, J.C. Hall, was

born in David City, Nebraska way back in 1891. Hall moved on to Norfolk before officially starting Hallmark in Kansas City in 1910.

More than 109 years later, Hallmark Movie Channel decided to throw a party to start their Countdown to Christmas event live in the place where Hall got his start. David City itself has a lot to celebrate as well, having just completed a two-year renovation of its downtown.

Bobbi Schmid, owner of Northside Inc. of David City, was part of the planning committee that helped get the event up and running.

Schmid said Hallmark Movie Channel came to the Butler County Chamber of Commerce a few months before the event to get the go-ahead. The chamber okayed the celebration and they hit the ground running.

"It was pretty fast and furious," Schmid said.

Sets started arriving and some were being built by local welders. Schmid said they stored a few of the sets before they were ready to be put in place.

In just a couple of days, they transformed downtown into a winter wonderland with garlands, trees, even a station for kids to meet Santa.

They'd been expecting maybe 200-300 kids to show up, Schmid said, but by the time everyone had arrived, the town had nearly doubled in size from its population of roughly 2,500 people.

It was a lot of effort for a one-day event, Schmid said, but they recently found out that Hallmark donated the sets back to David City and they'll be setting up for a holiday celebration every Wednesday until Christmas between 6 and 8 p.m. along the five-block stretch of downtown David City.
