Lottery Tickets Aren't Child's Play.

Nebraska Lottery tickets can help you spread instant joy this holiday season. But when you're making up your gift list, only give tickets to people who are old enough to play.

By law, Nebraska Lottery tickets may only be purchased and redeemed by persons who are 19 years or older.

The Nebraska Lottery is participating in the 2021 Gift Responsibly Campaign coordinated by National Council on Problem Gambling and the International Centre for Youth Gambling Problems and High-Risk Behaviors at McGill University. Participants agree to help raise awareness about the risks of underage lottery play during the holiday season. We will distribute responsible giving information via a press release and posts on social media.

Retailers can help us raise awareness by reminding players to gift responsibly. No matter how clever or attractive a game may be, it should always be played in moderation and only be given to individuals who are of legal age to play.

Conversion Update

The transition to the new lottery terminal system is complete. However, work continues to add additional features for lottery retailers.

New winner awareness slides will be added to the customer display show soon. These slides list the total number of winners in your store, city, or county. Additional slides will appear on your display when your location sells a high-tier Scratch or Lotto winning ticket.

The next step in the conversion process is the rollout of the Retailer Wizard system and Smart Count.

Retailer Wizard will give stores information about their lottery sales and other important lottery topics in one easy-to-use website. Retailer Wizard will be rolled out soon to a test group of retailers and then expand to all retailers later.

Smart Count is a method for tracking and balancing Scratch ticket sales at retail. This is an optional feature and your LSR will discuss if Smart Count is a good fit for your store in the future.

Gold Rush



Looking to add a little color to your luck? Check out our new \$1 Gold Rush and \$5 Super Gold Rush tickets.

Scratch off the latex above the play area and you'll discover all the familiar symbols, but with a new twist: color!

These are the first Nebraska Lottery Scratch tickets to feature full-color printing. They'll be released in stores at the end of January.



Sleigh Full of Joy Second-Chance promotion

While this time of year is usually quite dark due to daylight savings, we are giving people a chance to brighten their days with the Sleigh Full of Joy Second-Chance promotion. Since October 25, players have been able to submit their non-winning holiday Scratch tickets for a chance to win up to \$5,000 in cash. People

say October is too early to begin spreading the holiday spirit, but we say nonsense.

Eligible tickets for the promotion include \$1 Merry Match 2!, \$3 Holiday Prize Lines and \$5 Grandma Got Run Over by a Reindeer. The winners selected in the first drawing held November 17 won \$1,000, \$3,000 and \$5,000.

The second drawing was held December 9 and the final drawing will be held January 6.

To be eligible for the final drawing, have your tickets in by January 5 at 11:59 p.m.

Holiday Scratch Games Close January 21

The holiday Scratch games Merry Match 2!, Holiday Prizes Lines, and Grandma Got Run Over by a Reindeer will close on January 21, 2022. Any of these games could close earlier if their top prizes are claimed.

This is the first time our holiday games have had a set closing date. We will send information about the closing via terminal messages, our website, and social posts starting in January. Please let your customers know that the holiday Scratch games will only be available for a limited time.

Holiday Operations

Please be aware that Scratch ticket shipments will be affected by the Christmas and New Year's holidays. Because UPS will not be making deliveries on Saturday, Dec. 25, Friday, Dec. 31, and Saturday, Jan. 1, you may receive more packs of tickets than normal. If ordering tickets, please account for the holiday weekends and order accordingly.

Nebraska Lottery offices will be closed Friday, Dec. 24, and Friday, Dec. 31, but Lotto drawings will occur as normal on those dates.

Nebraska Pick 3 In-Store Coupon

A new coupon pad is coming to Nebraska Lottery retailers in January. Players can get one Nebraska Pick 3 Straight/Box play for 7 draws for \$5 – a \$2 discount. Scan the coupon to produce the discounted ticket.

For a \$2 entry fee and \$1 a raffle ticket, visitors can try to win their favorite trees at the event. Some are filled with expensive toys, some with top-shelf booze, there was one tree decked out in just McDonald's ornaments and gift cards. They also had a chance to win the Nebraska Lottery's tree, filled with little surprises and a full pack of Grandma Got Run Over By a Reindeer Scratch tickets.

This was our second year participating. Our first tree was in 2019, but with the pandemic, we had to wait another year to get our second one up. Our Winning Retailers



RETAILER SPOTLIGHT



There's a pretty lucky corner in Lincoln when it comes to selling winning Nebraska Lottery tickets.

At the crossroads of 56th and Holdrege Streets sits Kwik Shop and Speedee Mart, kitty-corner from one another, and they've each sold their fair share of winners.

Back in August, Kwik Shop sold a \$150,000-winning Nebraska Pick 5 ticket. In 2020 they sold a \$5,000 MyDaY jackpot-winning ticket. In 2014, they sold an \$82,000 Nebraska Pick 5 ticket.

Speedee Mart has a whole bunch of winners under its belt as well. Two years ago they sold a Truck\$ & Buck\$ winner that netted its purchaser a new Ford F-150 and in 2020 a player from their store won a Nebraska Lottery MVP club second-chance promotion and asked if they could accept their prize—a Traeger Grill—in front of the store.

The corner of 56th and Holdrege is pretty heavy with foot traffic. It sits smack dab in the middle of a dense residential area about a mile away from UNL's East Campus and Wesleyan College. It's also a busy street and the two stores are the only place to get gas for about two miles. That makes the difference when you're heading downtown and the gas gage is tipping dangerously close to "E".

Before Speedee Mart changed to its current name, they'd sold quite a few big winners. As Roc's Shop & Shop, they sold a \$100,000-winning Crossword Doubler Scratch ticket in 2014, a \$50,000 Triple Tripler winner also in 2014 and a \$22,000 2by2 winning ticket in 2013.

Even though they've had a whole lot of Lotto winners, that's not most of their business, said Kwik Shop assistant manager Chad Parker. Usually they sell about 90 percent Scratch and 10 percent Lotto, he said, but he does know the regulars who come in to play the Lotto games.

"The Pick 5 winner in August, I know who that is," Parker said. "They're going to

be spending winter somewhere warm."

Parker also said there was a lot of crossover play between Speedee Mart and Kwik Shop. If a player stops feeling lucky on Scratch tickets at one location, they'll walk across the street to try their luck somewhere else.

"We've got a lot of players in this neighborhood," Parker said. "We kind of share Lottery customers."
