

In 1996, the Nebraska Lottery introduced a new \$2 Scratch game: Truck\$ & Buck\$. The game soon became a customer favorite as players purchased Truck\$ & Buck\$ tickets for a chance to win a new vehicle. Over the years, dozens of Ford, Chevrolet, Dodge, and Toyota vehicles have been given away to lucky Nebraska Lottery players, and our players look forward to the return of the game each summer. It is interesting to note that even with gas prices rising, the game rated highest in recent web-based game testing.

The 2008 edition of Truck\$ & Buck\$ is the twelfth edition offered by the Nebraska Lottery. Three 2008 Toyota Tundra 4x4 Double Cab trucks are available as top prizes in the game, as well as \$492,200 in cash and Ethanol-enriched fuel prizes. A fourth Toyota Tundra is available in the game's second chance contest, which will culminate Labor Day weekend with a Grand Prize giveaway during the Nebraska State Fair.

A full complement of broadcast advertising has been developed to support Truck\$ & Buck\$. The Truck\$ television ads feature the familiar park ranger characters featured in previous campaigns. Our rangers find the herd of Tundras in both town and country: trucks that are at home anywhere. Filming for the commercial took place at locations in downtown Wahoo and at Czechland Lake Recreation Area near Prague. Radio advertising for Truck\$ & Buck\$ takes a different approach, promoting the Ethanol-enriched fuel prizes and the fact that Tundra prize includes all taxes paid by the Nebraska Lottery.



Fairfield Woman Wins \$66,000 Playing Nebraska Pick 5

Dorothy Bissantz of Fairfield won \$66,000 playing Nebraska Pick 5 from the Nebraska Lottery.

Bissantz is a regular Nebraska Lottery player who purchases Nebraska Pick 5 tickets every week. For the June 7 drawing, she purchased a single-play quick pick ticket at Ken & Al's Service, 308 North D Street in Fairfield. The ticket contained all five of the winning numbers (4, 17, 31, 33, 34) from the June 7 drawing for the \$66,000 jackpot.



While claiming her prize, Bissantz told Nebraska Lottery officials that she learned of her win after watching the KGIN Channel 11 television news on the night of the drawing. The next morning, her sister called the Nebraska Lottery Player's Hotline (800-224-LUCK) and dictated the winning numbers to Bissantz while she double-checked her ticket. Bissantz stated that, "we called the hotline three times" before realizing that she had won the \$66,000 jackpot. Bissantz plans to pay for home remodeling using her winnings.

The odds of winning the Nebraska Pick 5 jackpot, which starts at \$50,000 and grows by \$4,000 each time it is not won, are 1 in 501,942 while the overall odds of winning a prize in the game are 1 in 8.

\$17,000 Ruby Red 7's Prize for Ashland Couple

Neil & Lucy Thorson of Ashland won \$17,000 playing the \$2 Scratch game Ruby Red 7's from the Nebraska Lottery.

The Thorsons are regular Nebraska Lottery Scratch players who purchase their tickets at No Frills Supermarket, 2301 Silver Street in Ashland. On Friday, June 13, Neil Thorson purchased \$50 worth of Scratch tickets and returned home to scratch them off with his wife. Harley-Davidson® Giveaway


