
# **Retailer Design 'em Contest Winner**

While claiming his prize on June 17, Carlson told Nebraska Lottery officials that he "couldn't believe it" when he scratched off the ticket. "I read and re-read it over and over, because I thought I only had 10 words instead of 11," said Carlson. He plans to pay bills and purchase a new vehicle using his winnings.

## **A Record-Breaking Year**

Our 20th Anniversary has been memorable in many vays, and with the end of the fiscal year on June 30, the ind our partners have several new reasons to celebrate. Sales of Scratch and Lotto tickets during Fiscal Year 2013 were \$160.8

million. While preliminary, this figure represents a 6.7% increase over the prior fiscal year and marks the highest yearly sales since 1993.

Some of the factors that influenced sales this year were continued growth in Scratch products and strong sales of our most-popular Lotto game, Powerball. We pride ourselves on developing Scratch games our players want to purchase. Additionally, the Last Shot! program is driving sales of Scratch games and allows us to turn over our inventory faster.

Powerball sales continue to grow after last year's game changes. We're benefitting from the higher jackpots and more millionaires that have resulted from the game changes. To date, there have been six \$1 million and two \$2 million Powerball winners in Nebraska, and overall we're paying out more in prizes per draw than before the game was changed.

Impressive sales figures are a great achievement, but we're also extremely proud of the benefits for Nebraska. More than \$40 million was transferred to our beneficiary funds during the fiscal year, \$3.9 million more than the previous year. Players also took home \$83.6 million in Nebraska

All of these records would not have been possible without the support of our retailer partners. Retailers received over \$10 million in commissions during the fiscal year, which is well-deserved compensation for promoting our products in their stores. Together, we are Building a Better Nebraska.

#### Family Wins \$1 Million Playing Mega Millions® with Megaplier®

Nebraska's newest Lottery millionaires have come forward to claim their prize. Loran and Peggy Kramer of Kimball and Kevin Kramer of West Valley, Utah, will split a \$1 million Mega Millions with Megaplier prize.

The Kramer family has been playing Nebraska Lottery games together for over five years, pooling their money to purchase tickets every week. For the Tuesday, June 18 drawing, Loran Kramer purchased a two-play quick pick Mega Millions with Megaplier ticket at Vince's Corner, 100 East 3rd Street in Kimball. One play on the ticket matched all five of the winning white ball numbers (6, 17, 34, 40, 48) for a \$250,000 prize.



Because he added the \$1 Megaplier option to his purchase, the \$250,000 prize was multiplied by the guaranteed 4X Megaplier number for a total of \$1 million. This is the fourth \$1 million Mega Millions prize won in Nebraska since the Nebraska Lottery began offering the game in March 2010.

Loran and his wife Peggy will split the million-dollar prize with their son Kevin. Kevin and Peggy arrived at Nebraska Lottery headquarters on June 20 to claim the prize. "I was checking nelottery.com, and I saw that Vince's Corner sold a winning ticket," said Peggy Kramer. "Just then, my husband starting yelling 'We won! We won!' in the next room. That's when I knew we had that ticket." When asked about plans for the prize money, Kevin Kramer told Nebraska Lottery officials that he planned to save his share for his son's education and for retirement savings. Peggy Kramer stated that that some of

the money would be used for home repairs and the rest saved for the future.

#### Mega Millions® **Enhancements Start** October 22



Starting with the October 22, 2013. drawing, Mega Millions players will see changes that include larger starting jackpots, faster growing jackpots, a million-dollar second prize, and better odds of winning any prize—all for the same \$1 players now pay.

Players will notice that the minimum jackpot will increase from \$12 million to \$15 million, and jackpots will grow by at least \$5 million after each drawing in which the jackpot is not won.

Mega Millions drawings will still consist of five white balls and one gold Mega Ball<sup>®</sup>, for a total of six winning numbers. Under a new matrix, the number of white balls will increase to 75 and the number of gold balls (the Mega Ball) will decrease to 15. The result will be overall odds of just 1 in 15 to win any prize.

Here are some of the other enhancements that players will see:


- The prize structure will change. For example, the second prize will increase from \$250,000 to \$1 million for matching the first five numbers.
- The Megaplier<sup>®</sup>, a multiplier option which players can purchase for an additional \$1 to increase their non-jackpot prizes, will be expanded to include a five factor. That means a Mega Millions ticket can now win up to \$5 million without matching all six numbers.

To prepare for the upcoming changes, the Nebraska Lottery is temporarily reducing the amount of drawings that can be purchased on a ticket. Each Wednesday, a terminal message will be sent out indicating the number of multi-draws that can be purchased for that week's drawings. Once the final drawing (October 18, 2013) under the game's current matrix has taken place, it will again be possible to purchase multi-draw tickets for up to 24 consecutive drawings.
