As a reminder, Lotto ticket stock is assigned to specific retailers by serial-numbered rolls, and rolls cannot be transferred from one retailer to another. This is for security purposes, as high-tier winners are subject to stock verification by Lottery security personnel. Never loan or borrow ticket stock to or from another retailer (not even from a store within your own company). If you need ticket stock, call the Lottery Retailer Hotline at 1-800-560-2919.

### Schuyler Man Wins \$66,000 Nebraska Pick 5 Jackpot

Ben Welch of Schuyler recently won \$66,000 playing Nebraska Pick 5 from the Nebraska Lottery.

Welch purchased his winning Nebraska Pick 5 ticket at Corner Stop, 220 23rd Street in Columbus. The three-play ticket contained one play with all five of the winning numbers (8, 11, 14, 22, 29) from the December 7 drawing for the \$66p,000 jackpot.

> Two hundred and thirty-six Nebraska Lottery players have won the Nebraska Pick 5 jackpot to date.

While claiming his prize on December 13, Welch told Nebraska Lottery officials that he didn't know he had won the jackpot prize at first. "I was on my way to work and I stopped at Corner Stop. The clerk told me to check my tickets because they'd sold a big winner," said Welch. He plans to pay bills using his winnings.

The odds of winning the Nebraska Pick 5 jackpot, which starts at \$50,000 and grows by \$4,000 each drawing that it is not won, are 1 in 501,942.

### \$10,000 Tree Trimmin' Tripler Prize for Beaver Crossing Man

Keith Pankoke of Beaver Crossing won \$10,000 playing the \$2 Scratch game Tree Trimmin' Tripler from the Nebraska Lottery.

Pankoke purchased his winning Tree Trimmin' Tripler ticket at Casey's General Store, 2605 Progressive Road in Seward. Scratching the ticket, he revealed matching numbers with a corresponding prize of \$10,000.

There are three \$10,000 top prizes available in Tree Trimmin' Tripler. Pankoke is the first person to claim a top prize to

date.

While claiming his prize on December 30, 2011, Pankoke told Nebraska Lottery officials that he didn't believe he had won at first when he scratched off the ticket. "My wife and I had to look at it several times," he said. Pankoke had no definite plans for his prize.

The odds of winning the \$10,000 top prize are 1 in 100,000, while the overall odds of winning any prize are 1 in 3.51.



# Accounting Tips & Tricks

A new year signals a time for new beginnings and starting new routines. Here are some accounting tips and tricks from the Nebraska Lottery to start 2012 off right.

- To avoid confusion, do not return validated Scratch or Lotto tickets to players unless the ticket has not been paid. If you encounter a problem validating a ticket and have not paid, give both the receipt and the ticket back to the customer and instruct them to claim their prize at a Nebraska Lottery Claim Center. Please write your first name on the receipt so Lottery Accounting can contact the proper person if they have any questions.
- If you have scanned a winning Scratch ticket and don't have enough cash on hand to pay, please call Lottery Accounting at 800-587-5200. Mark the back of the ticket as "not paid" along with your name and date. Give both the receipt and the ticket back to the customer and instruct them to claim their prize at a Nebraska Lottery Claim Center.
- If a communication error occurs on your Lotto terminal during a transaction, you can touch the Last Transactions button, then touch **Last Transaction** to check if the transaction was successfully completed and the value of the last validation.
- Activated, settled and returned Scratch ticket reports are available for one week after a new Weekly Settlement Report has printed.
- Once a pack is activated, payment for that pack will post whichever comes first of the following two scenarios: 45 days after activation or when 70% of the pack has been sold (which is determined by validations).
- Prizes from closed Scratch games or expired Lotto tickets cannot be claimed. If a customer tries to redeem a ticket from a closed or expired ticket, remind them that prizes can be redeemed up to 180 days after the closing date (for Scratch tickets) or 180 days after the drawing date (for Lotto tickets). Prizes from these tickets cannot be claimed by mailing them to the Nebraska Lottery or by directing players to visit a Lottery Claim
- If the box code on the front of a Scratch ticket is unreadable, instruct the player to mail the ticket to the Nebraska Lottery at the prize claim P.O. Box on the back of the ticket to claim their prize.



# Coupons

The Nebraska Lottery has begun to issue loose coupons for both Scratch and Lotto tickets again. These coupons are similar to the coupons issued in the past. One difference you may notice about the new Scratch coupons is that they can be validated without entering a box code: Just scan the barcode to receive credit for the

If you are unable to scan the barcode on a coupon, touch MANUAL VALIDATION on the terminal, then touch REDEEM SCRATCH COUPON or REDEEM LOTTO COUPON. Enter all of the digits underneath the barcode to complete the validation.
